Revelation 1:1–2, NIV84 - ¹ <u>The revelation* of Jesus Christ,</u> which God gave him to show his servants what must <u>soon take place</u> [ἐν τάχος, "must come to pass with rapidity"(Tachometer)]. He made it known by sending his angel to his servant John, ² who testifies to everything he saw—that is, the word of God and the testimony of Jesus Christ.

*Revelation – Gk: ἀποκάλυψις, apokalypsis, means, "unveil", "to reveal", or "to make clear"—The Book of Revelation is not a riddle!

2. A is revealed.

Revelation 1:3, NIV84 - ³ <u>Blessed</u> is the one who <u>reads</u> the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who <u>hear</u> it and <u>take to heart</u> what is written in it, because the <u>time</u> [καιρός, "seasons"] is near.

Want a blessing? Then read...hear...keep God's Word!

3. The ______ is revealed.

Revelation 1:4–5, NLT -⁴ This letter is from John to the seven churches in the province of Asia. Grace and peace to you from the one who is, who always was, and who is still to come; from the sevenfold Spirit before his throne; ⁵ and from Jesus Christ. He is the faithful witness to these things, the first to rise from the dead, and the ruler of all the kings of the world. All glory to him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by shedding his blood for us.

4. A is revealed.

Revelation 1:5–7, NIV84 - 5 and from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood, 6 and has made us to be a kingdom and priests to serve his God and Father—to him be glory and power for ever and ever! Amen. 7 Look, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, even those who pierced him; and all the peoples [y $\hat{\eta}$, "lost people who have rejected God"] of the earth will mourn [κόπτω, "cut off"] because of him. So shall it be! Amen.

5. A is revealed.

Revelation 1:8, NIV84 - 8 "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "who is, and who was, and who is to come, the Almighty."

Jesus-Revealed!

Jesus is the <u>Proclaimer</u>—"Who is the faithful witness" – v. 5a

Jesus is the <u>Proof</u> (resurrection)—"firstborn from the dead" – v. 5b

Jesus is the <u>Prince</u>—"prince/ruler of the kings" – v. 5c

Jesus is the <u>Propitiation</u>—"freed us from our sins by His blood"–v. 5d

Jesus is the <u>Priest</u>—"[He has] made us a kingdom of priests" – v. 6a

Jesus is our <u>Promise</u>—"Look, He is coming...." – v. 7
