# 1. DIFFICULT SITUATIONS

#### A. From Sin

Psalm 143:2 (ESV)-Enter not into judgment with your servant, <u>for no one living is righteous before you.</u>

#### B. From the Enemy

Psalm 143:3 (ESV)-For the enemy has pursued my soul; he has crushed my life to the ground; he has made me sit in darkness like those long dead.

John 10:10 (ESV)-The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.

#### C. From the Lord

I Peter 4:19 (ESV)-Therefore <u>let those who suffer according to God's will</u> entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good.

Psalm 63:1 (ESV)-O God, you are my God; earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water.

#### B. For His Voice

Psalm 143:7-8 (ESV)-Answer me quickly, O Lord! My spirit fails! Hide not your face from me, lest I be like those who go down to the pit. Let me hear in the morning of your steadfast love, for in you I trust.
