2. CONFIRMATION—God is supreme

Revelation 2:1, NIV84 - ¹ "To the angel of the church in Ephesus write: <u>These are the words of him who holds the seven stars in his</u> right hand and walks among the seven golden lampstands:

3. COMMENDATION—"I know your deeds"

Serving ● Sacrificing ● Steadfast ● Separated

Revelation 2:2–3, 6, NIV84 - ² I know your deeds, your hard work and your perseverance. I know that you cannot tolerate wicked men, that you have tested those who claim to be apostles but are not, and have found them false. ³ You have persevered and have endured hardships for my name, and have not grown weary... ⁶ you have this in your favor: You hate the practices of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.

4. COMPLAINT—"You have left your first love"

Revelation 2:4, NASB95 - 4 'But I have this against you, that <u>you</u> have left your first love.

12 Evidences That I Have Left My "First Love"

- 1. When my delight in the Lord is no longer as great as my delight in someone or something.
- 2. When my soul does not long for times of rich fellowship in God's Word or prayer.
- 3. When my thoughts during leisure moments do not reflect upon the Lord.
- 4. When I claim to be "only human" and easily give in to those things I know displease God.
- 5. When I do not willingly and cheerfully give to God's work or to the needs of others.
- 6. When I cease to treat every Christian brother as I would the Lord.
- 7. When I view the commands of Christ as restrictions to my happiness rather than expressions of His love
- 8. When I inwardly strive for the acclaim of the world rather than the approval of the Lord.
- 9. When I fail to make Christ or His Word known because I fear rejection.
- 10. When I become complacent to sinful conditions around me.
- 11. When I refuse to give up an activity which I know is offending a weaker brother.
- 12. When I am unable to forgive another for offending me.

Revelation 2:4, NIV84 - ⁴ Yet I hold this against you: You have <u>forsaken</u> [ἀφίημι—lit., "to let go of" meaning "to dismiss someone from your presence"; it doesn't mean that you "lost it"; it means you deliberately "left it" or specifically, "let go" of it—You let go of God!] *your first love*.

"First Love" is that fervent, personal, uninhibited, heartfelt, excited and openly displayed love for God to whom you are fully committed.

5. COMMAND—Return to "

"

Remember ● Repent ● Repeat

Revelation 2:5, NIV84 - ⁵ Remember the height from which you have fallen! Repent and do the things you did at first. If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place.

6. COMFORT—I am coming for you who love Me.

Revelation 2:7, NIV84 - ⁷ He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes, <u>I will give the</u> right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God.
