REVIEW FROM LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE:

- The church at Smyrna was the faithful church—"Faithful Unto Death."
- Our persecution and pain is temporary; our riches are eternal.
- We are not to be fearful, but faithful to God—even unto death.
- Jesus Christ is coming again to rescue those who believe in Him.



1. CHURCH—The Church in Pergamum.

Revelation 2:12, NIV84 -¹² "To the angel of the church in Pergamum write... [The common name **Pergamos** (Proper form: Pergamum) – [Gk. Πέργαμος] The Greek prefix *per*, seen in words like "pervert," means *opposition*. The suffix *gamos*, like "monogamy," means "marriage." Pergamos, then, means "perverted marriage" or "objectionable marriage"—a fitting description of this culture."

2. CONFIRMATION—Jesus carries a two-edged sword—a symbol of his power and authority.

Revelation 2:12, NIV84 -¹² "To the angel of the church in Pergamum write: These are the words of him who has the sharp, double-edged sword."

- **The Sword of Pergamos**—dedicated to Aesculapius (which gives us our word *scalpel*); this false god of healing was symbolized by a serpent wrapped around a pole—it's still used today.

- **The Sword of Rome**—Roman soldiers carried them.
- **The Sword of Christ**—Rev. 2:12, TLB - "This message is from him who wields the sharp and double-bladed sword."

3. COMMENDATION—They live at "Satan's Throne."

Revelation 2:13, NIV84 -¹³ "I know where you live—where Satan has his throne. Yet you remain true to my name. You did not renounce your faith in me, even in the days of Antipas [According to the historian Tertullian, Antipas, a physician, wouldn't renounce his faith in Christ and was therefore "fried to death"], *my faithful witness, who was put to death in your city—where Satan lives.*"

4. COMPLAINT—They compromised their moral standards by drifting into worldliness.

Revelation 2:14–15, NIV84 -¹⁴ "Nevertheless, I have a few things against you: You have people there who hold to the teaching of Balaam [A false prophet who failed to curse the Israelites and then devised another plan; cf., Numbers 22, "If your women seduce the Israelite men...they can introduce idol worship to them through which Israel will thereby bring a curse upon herself"], *who taught Balak* [The Moabite king that wanted the curse on his enemy, Israel] *to entice the Israelites to sin by eating food sacrificed to idols and by committing sexual immorality.*¹⁵ *Likewise you also have those who hold to the teaching of the Nicolaitans.*" [Remember, they taught that objectionable sexual practices of the world were not a sin].

"Compromising or *tolerance* is the virtue of a man with no conviction!" - Pastor Joe

5. COMMAND—Repent and stick with The Word.

Revelation 2:16, NIV84 -¹⁶ "Repent therefore! Otherwise, I will soon come to you and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth."

6. COMFORT—If you repent, I'll give you manna, a white stone, and a new name.

Revelation 2:17, TLB -¹⁷ "Let everyone who can hear, listen to what the Spirit is saying to the churches: Everyone who is victorious shall eat of the hidden manna, the secret nourishment from heaven; and I will give to each a white stone, and on the stone will be engraved a new name..."
