A Reminder of Our Past (The Negative)

1. We have a _____ past.

STUDY VERSE SECTION - 1 Peter 2:9, NASB95 -⁹ *But you are A chosen [Gk: ek-lek-tos, lit., picked out, chosen; Salvation is based on the sovereign electing purposes of God—its speaks to the sovereignty of God] race [Gk: GENE-os, means from the same genetic stock—in this case “royal blood”, A royal! [this gives us our Eng. word “basilica,” a royal residence or palace] PRIESTHOOD, A holy [lit., “to cut,” it means to separate or set apart for a sacred purpose] nation [Gk: ethnos, meaning people], A PEOPLE FOR God's OWN possession [means “to purchase” or “to acquire for a price”, so that you may proclaim [gives us our word “evangelism”] the excellencies [lit., heroic deeds] of Him who has called you out of darkness [rf., sinful state] into His marvelous light...*

STUDY VERSE SECTION - 1 Peter 2:10a, NASB95 -¹⁰ *for you once were NOT A PEOPLE [Heb. (Hos. 2) is translated “despised” meaning outcast, fallen, or homeless], but now you are THE PEOPLE OF GOD;...*

STUDY VERSE SECTION - 1 Peter 2:10, NASB95 -¹⁰ *...you had NOT RECEIVED MERCY [rf., you were not saved], but now you have RECEIVED MERCY.*
